# 1. Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 947 requests for service during the month of November. Community Service responded to 106 requests for service.

The patrol division had another busy month handling calls for service. School zones are being patrolled during the drop off and pick up times to provide a safe environment for the children.

This report is generally for activities of the patrol division; but this month one of the patrol officers was recognized as a member of the community. Corporal Alvin Luker was recognized as the outstanding 4-H Leader of the year in Moffat County. Corporal Luker is one of the leaders in the shooting sports 4-H program. For the last several years, he has helped the youth of our community become one of the top shooting teams in the state of Colorado.

Tracy Mendoza started as the new Patrol Officer on 11-21-16. He has completed the first two weeks of training and has been doing a great job. Tracy will be a great team member for our agency.

# 4. Investigations - Commander Bill Leonard

• As stated many times before, the Internet can be a great tool for our youth if managed properly; but sadly once again it has prompted dangerous behaviors leading to painful consequences. New U-Tube game-people drench clothing with flammable liquid, start themselves on fire and then jump in a pool or shower. Of course, they film the whole episode and post on U-Tube to challenge

or "dare" others to do the same behavior. Two of our local youth watched some of these videos and decided to this might be fun. In their video, there was no pool or shower to jump in and the one filming the event is the one who started the other one on fire. Result- one young man flown to Denver with severe burns and another one now facing serious charges. Unfortunately, they were only 11 and 12 years old.

Officer Rimmer and Officer Fritz continue to teach DARE to Sunset and Sandrock  $5^{th}$  grades.

Officer Fritz is temporarily working patrol shifts in order to cover our personnel shortfall, he has been working within the school as call loads allow in order to stay involved with the schools and school activities


