1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,283 requests for service during the month of June. Community Service responded to 182 requests for service.

Calls for service were steady for the month.

For this month, we saw an increase in thefts. We responded to a total of 17 theft cases this month. One of our businesses brought in their loss prevention team to Craig, which generated several cases. The individuals that were apprehended were cited for theft; or in some cases were arrested. We also had several thefts from vehicles. Most of these the vehicles were not locked, making it easier for the thefts to occur.

We handled several mental health calls this month. Some of these individuals were in crisis and ultimately had to be transported to Grand Junction for treatment. In the last ten days of June, we transported four individuals for treatment.

I sound like a broken record, but the trend continues again this month. As in previous months, officers are contacting individuals for different violations and these individuals are being charged with drug related crimes. This month we had eight cases of individuals charged with drug related violations. The majority of the crimes are associated with methamphetamine and methamphetamine drug paraphernalia

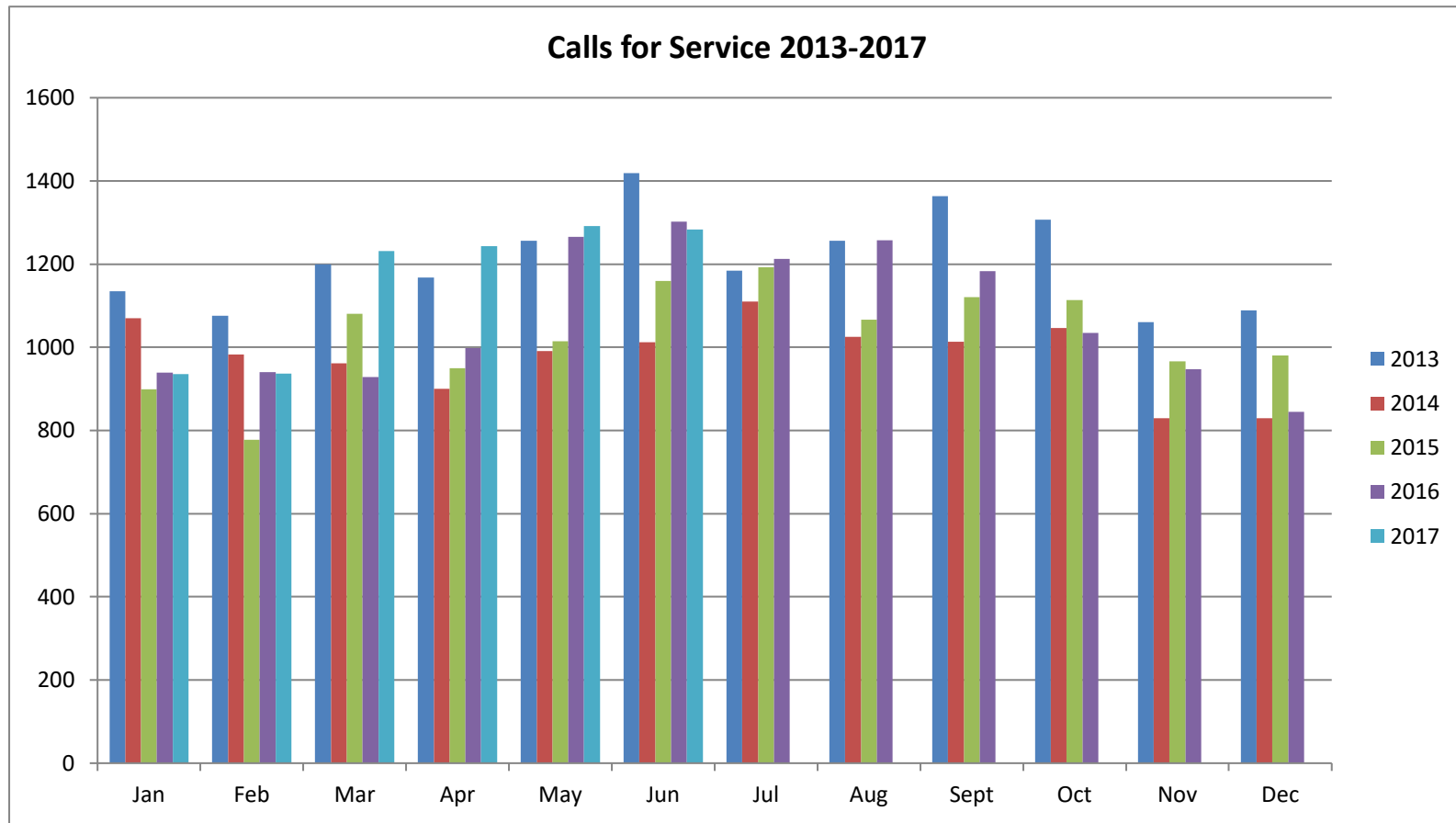
