SUBJECT: Progress Report – September 2016

1. Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 1,183 requests for service during the month of August. Community Service responded to 127 requests for service.

The patrol division had another busy month handling calls for service. School zones are being patrolled during the drop off and pick up times to provide a safe environment for the children.

This month was busy for warrant arrests. These warrants were mainly for failure to comply with court orders or failure to appear. Several of these arrestees were also in possession of a controlled substance and were charged accordingly.

Interesting call for the month: A person lost some property at a local business. The owner went back to the business looking for the property. The owner left his name and contact information with the clerk of the business. The property was found and the property turned out to be illegal drugs. The patrol officers working that night were able to contact the owner of the property. A meeting was set up to return his property. The patrol officers were able to contact the owner and he was arrested. This was a great job by the officers.

On a side note, during the regular Special Response Team (SRT) training, all members present were trained to drive the MRAP. With this training completed we are getting closer to put the MRAP into service for both agencies.

2. Community Service

CSOs Josh Wright and Jill Nelson handled the following calls during the month of September.

3. Miscellaneous

September 27^{th} , officer testing was conducted for the vacant patrol position. Only two applicants tested. The written was not a pass/fail. Both applicants moved onto the oral boards. Detective Young conducted the physical agility testing.

4. Investigations - Commander Bill Leonard

Cases

Two young people enjoying Craig City Park found an SD card on the ground. Trying to do the right thing, they decided to check for files on the card to attempt to identify the owner. What they found immediately prompted them to again do the right thing and bring the card to the police department. The very explicit child pornography on the card prompted a fast-team work investigation with Travis Young and Jen Kenney as the lead investigators. Several hours later this resulted in the arrest of a Craig resident for several charges including sexual exploitation of children, sexual assault on a child and aggravated incest. The investigation continues and several more potential victims of this same suspect are being interviewed. These types of case have a huge impact on all involved, including the officers that have to investigate them. I commend Travis and Jen and all the other staff involved for their prompt and very professional handling of this horrendous case.


