1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,138 requests for service during the month of May. Community Service responded to 162 requests for service.

We had a local car dealership call wanting assistance with a possible scam. A person came in to the dealership wanting to purchase numerous vehicles. Officers were sent to the business when the person came back to the dealership. After listening to the person for some time, he was contacted. After a prolonged conversation with the person, the male finally told the officers his real name. The male had a warrant in Garfield County and a warrant from Morgan County. He was taken in to custody for the warrants and local charges.

Toward the end of the month, there was an increase in thefts from vehicles. The victims of these crimes left their vehicles unlocked and items were taken. To avoid being a victim of a crime of opportunity, vehicle owners need to secure their vehicles and not leave valuables in their vehicles.

Thank you to Moffat County Communities That Care Northwest Colorado Health. They dropped off trays of goodies for Police Week.



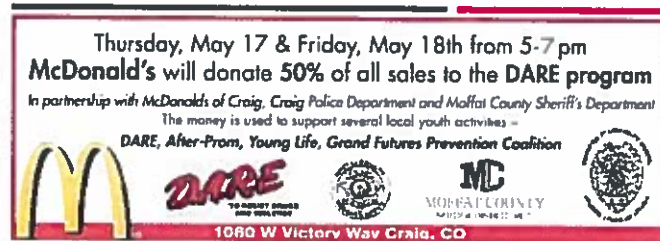
May 5th, we had a great group of eager young riders participate in the Bike Rodeo. We saw a lot of good habits being formed!



May 8th, SRO Fritz and Eddie Eagle taught gun safety to students at Eagle's Nest Preschool.



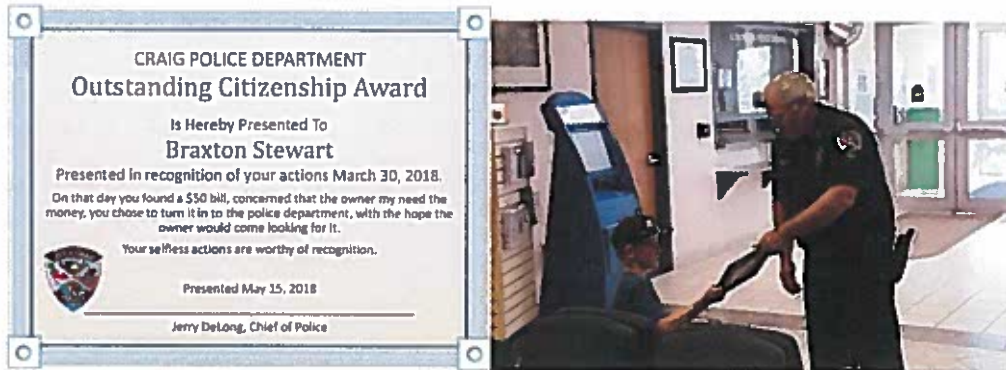
May 17th and 18th, SAPP and the DARE program held their annual fundraiser at McDonald's.

June 14th through 16th, department personnel will assist with Whittle the Wood activities.

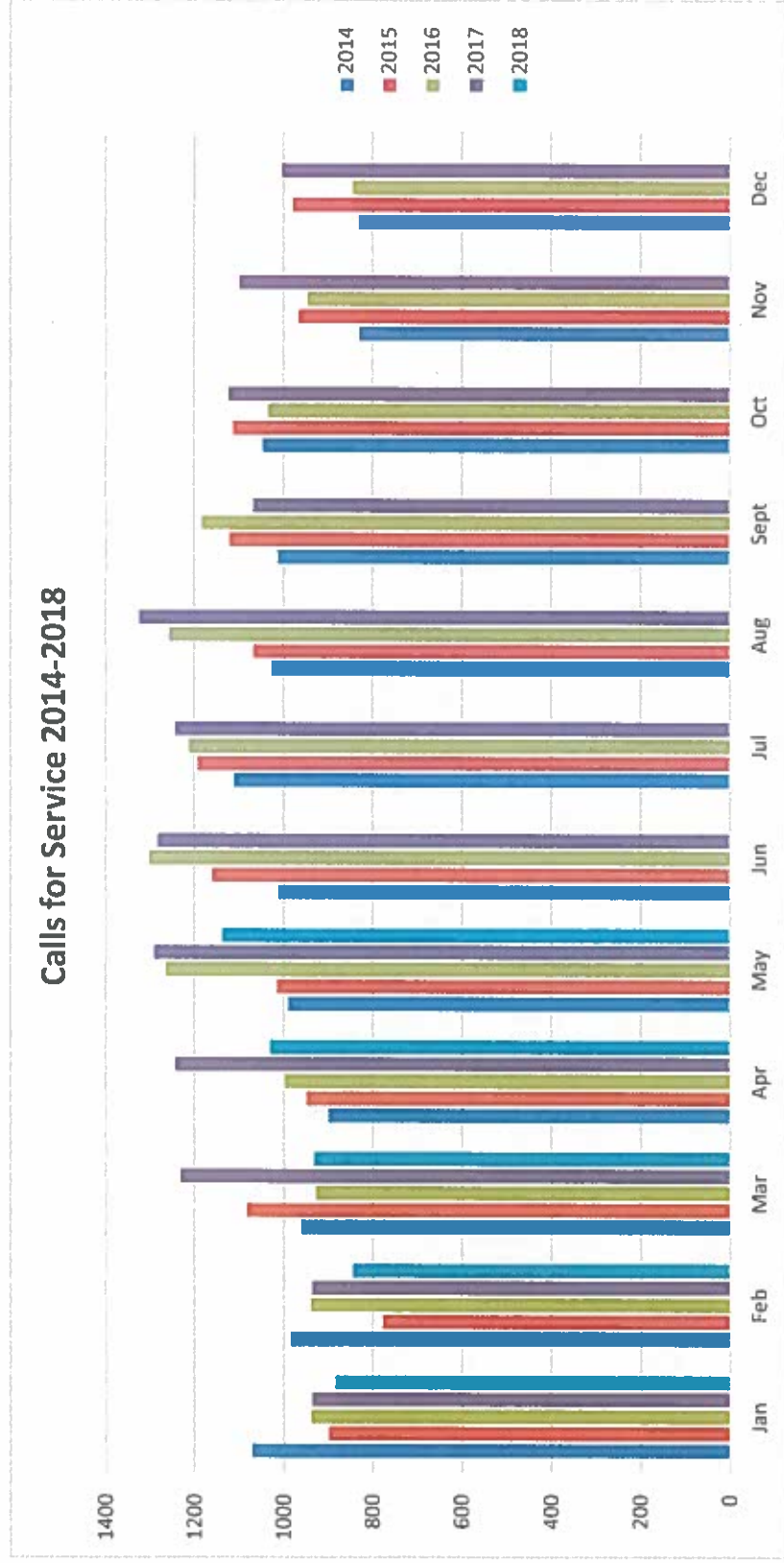
