1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

See attachments. The department responded to 1,149 requests for service during the month of May. Community Service responded to 175 requests for service.

Calls for service were steady for the month of May. The SROs and patrol division was busy with end of school activities, but the schools closed for the summer with no major incidents.

We saw an increase in warrant arrests. Seventeen individuals were arrested on warrants. Many had more than one warrant at the time they were arrested and some also picked up additional charges for giving false names or having illegal items in their possession.

Domestic Violence related incidents also increased. We responded to 9 calls for service for Domestic violence. Several of these incidents resulted in arrests for domestic violence related charges and other crimes.

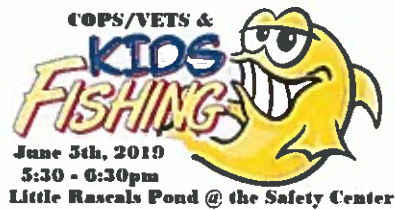

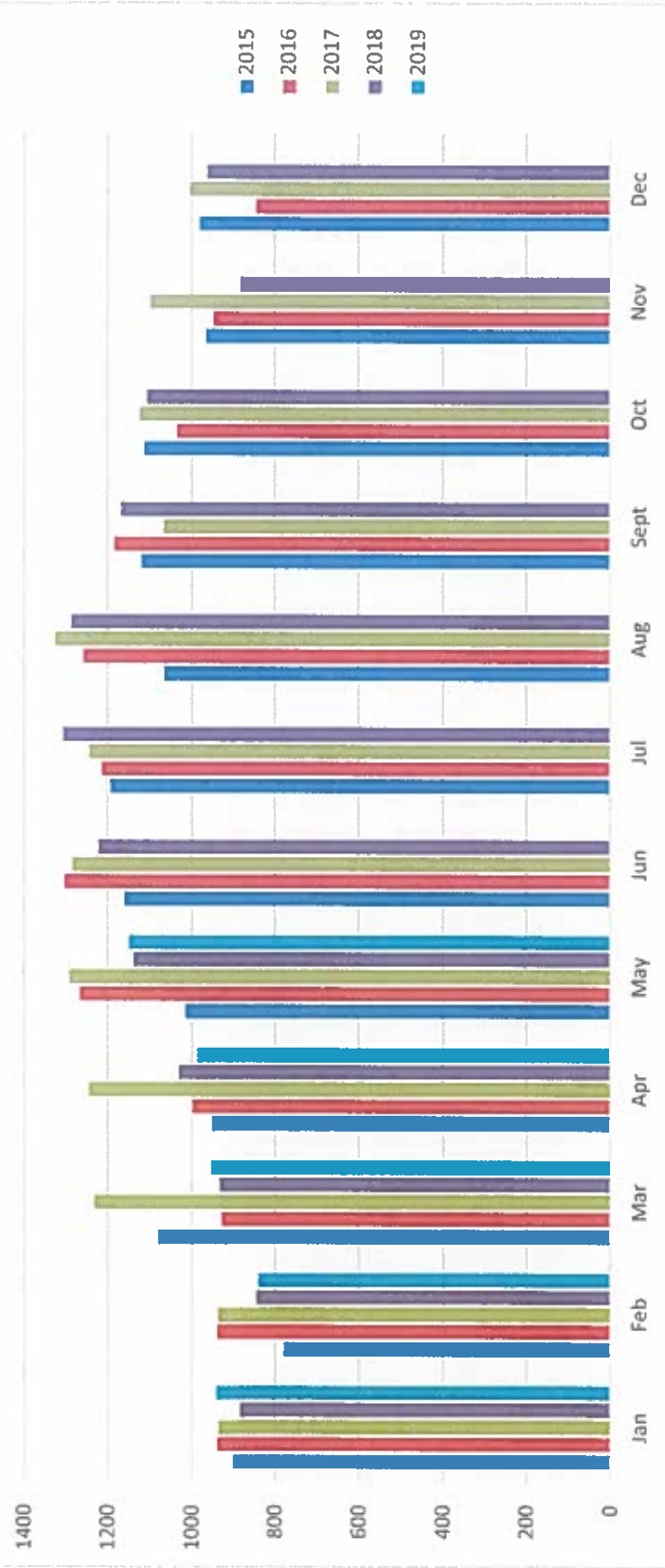
