Crime and Patrol Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 1,098 requests for service during the month of November. Community Service responded to 146 requests for service.

This month, we continued to have the drug related arrests as in previous months.

We saw an increase of reported thefts. The thefts range from less than \$50 to over \$20,000. Several of the thefts were from vehicles and front yards.

The large theft was from a local business. The Loss Control Division of the business was able to set up surveillance to catch the employee in the act of taking the funds. A warrant was issued for the suspect.

Another theft was over \$7,000. A person cashed a stolen check from a Steamboat Springs company at a local business. Together with the information provided by the victims and working with the Steamboat Springs Police Department, a warrant will be issued shortly for the suspect.


