## 1. *Crime and Patrol Summary*

*See attachments. The department responded to 1,067 requests for service during the month of September. Community Service responded to 135 requests for service.*

*We are providing extra patrols in the school zones to make it as safe as we can for the students and motoring public. This month two summonses were issued in school zones for traffic violations.*

*This month, officers handled an incident where two vehicles were stolen during the night/early morning hours. The suspect took one vehicle and then dropped it off and then took another vehicle. During the incident, the suspect entered another vehicle and left a backpack inside this vehicle. The backpack contained an ID card with the suspect's information and possible meth was also located in the backpack. The officers were able to track down the suspect and he was arrested. After the arrest, the officers were notified a weapon was taken out of another vehicle in the same area of where one of the vehicles was abandoned. The officers responded back to the residence where the suspect was arrested. The occupants of the residence provided the officers with the stolen weapon. The suspect was charged with numerous criminal charges. A job well done by the officers involved!*

*October 31<sup>st</sup>, department personnel will participate in the Halloween Downtown Fair.*

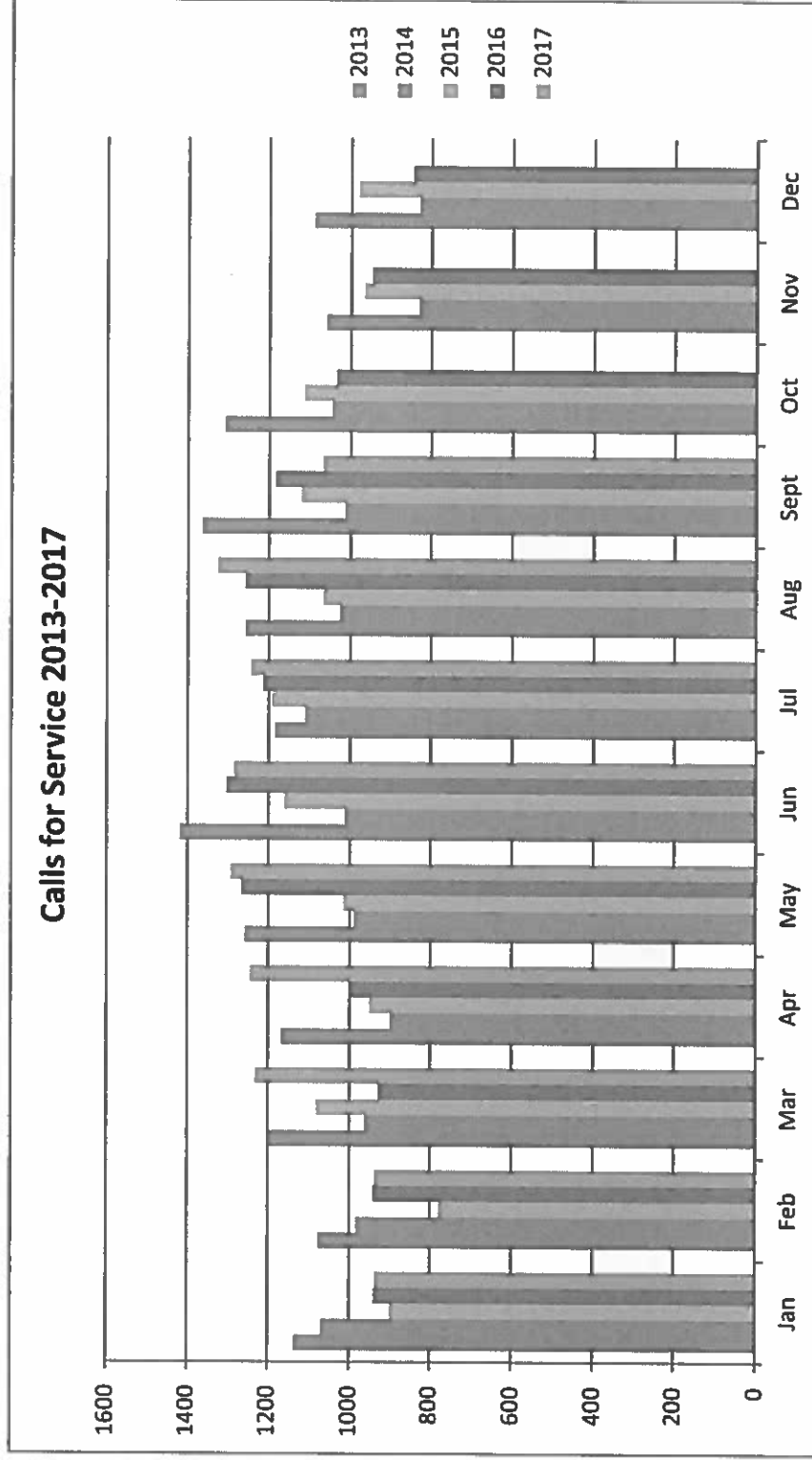
